Dear friends,

By now you've noticed that Capitol Hill Group Ministry has a new logo and a new name—Everyone Home DC. I am proud to share this new brand with you because I believe it is a powerful reflection of who we are and what we stand for.

For more than 50 years, Capitol Hill Group Ministry—now Everyone Home DC—has partnered with people experiencing homelessness, caring neighbors, fellow advocates, and city officials to end homelessness in DC. However, much has changed since our founding by interfaith leaders on Capitol Hill so many years ago. As we kicked off our 50th anniversary celebration in 2018, it was time to adopt a name that was truer to our mission, more reflective of our community, and more in line with our vision for our city as a ***thriving and diverse community, where all people can obtain and remain in safe, affordable, and comfortable homes.***

Everyone Home DC is a name and a mission statement in one. It is also more welcoming of our diverse range of supporters and reflects our service to all eight wards. **Despite our name change, our focused commitment to and deep care for our community continues,** with a rigorous set of solutions for people experiencing homelessness.

Last year, Everyone Home DC provided housing stabilization services to nearly 800 families at imminent risk of homelessness, and 94% of them were able to avoid a traumatic shelter stay as a result. Our Shirley's Place Day Center provided more than 2,000 individuals with a clean, safe place to shower, do laundry, eat nutritious meals, and access computers, new clothing, transportation, and rental assistance. And our Street Outreach team supported more than 400 chronically homeless individuals in meeting their immediate and long term goals. **This was all thanks to you.**

Each year, we rely on your time, treasure, and thoughtful partnership to help us end homelessness. The past year was no exception. I am grateful for the love you have shown to us and those who rely on us in times of profound crisis. I invite you to learn more about the impact your support has made possible in the pages that follow. **Thank you for sharing our vision of Everyone Home DC!**
